- 2-We think it should probably be classified as a Heritage Home as it has a long history of Prince George business people and Doctors who have resided in it.
- 3-The property has many magnificent Birch Trees which would be lost if a other house was built in front of it and that would detract from the whole McBride Crescent which is blessed with wonderful mature trees which are now in wonderful fall colours.
- 4-In 1982 I talked to City Hall about splitting our 3 lots and building on one side. The City at that time stated that they wanted to keep crescents as low density residential area. What has changed since then.
- 5-Our sewer, water infastructure is quite old, at least 60 years so will it take more inbuilding?
- 6-This point really disturbs me. I see that survey pegs have already been put in and that the City has already put in Water and Sewer to the property line. Does this mean that the City has already given permission for this change?
