RECOMMENDATION:

That Council NOMINATES and APPOINTS one of its members to serve on the Prince George Public Library Board for a one-year term beginning December 1, 2021.

PURPOSE:

The purpose of this report is to seek Council's decision with respect to the nomination and appointment of one (1) member of Council to serve as Council Representative to the Prince George Public Library Board.

DISCUSSION:

The Prince George Public Library Board consists of nine (9) members. One (1) member of Council is selected to sit on the Board, and eight (8) members are appointed by Council from applications received from residents or electors of the municipality.

The *Library Act* requires that the member of Council appointed to the Library Board serve for a term of one year and that no member may serve for more than eight (8) consecutive years. Due to the October 15, 2022 general local election, the length of the term will be less than one year. Councillor Terri McConnachie has served as Council Representative to the Board for six (6) one-year terms with her current term expiring on November 30, 2021.

SUMMARY:

It is recommended that one member of Council be appointed to serve as Council Representative on the Library Board for a one-year term beginning December 1, 2021.
