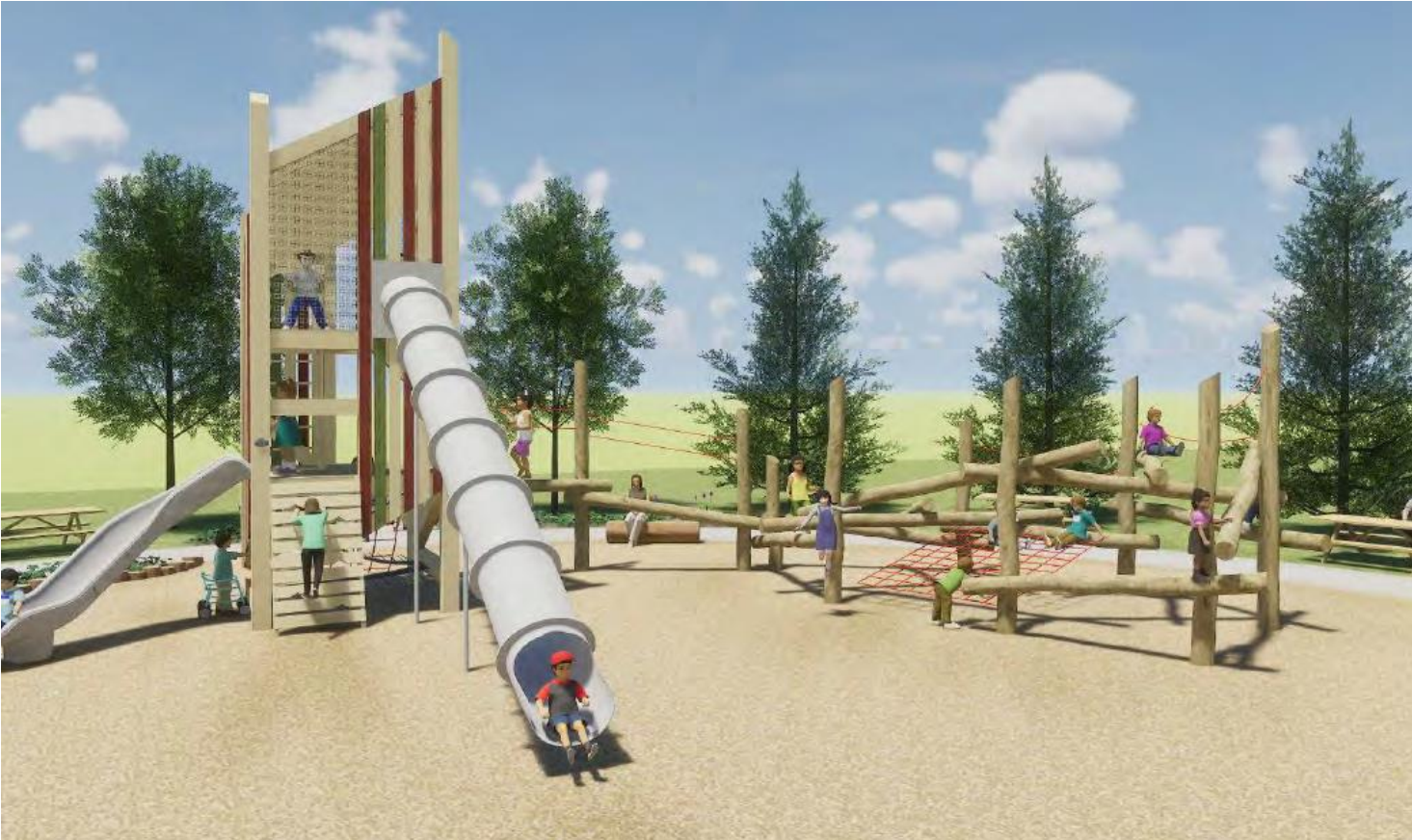

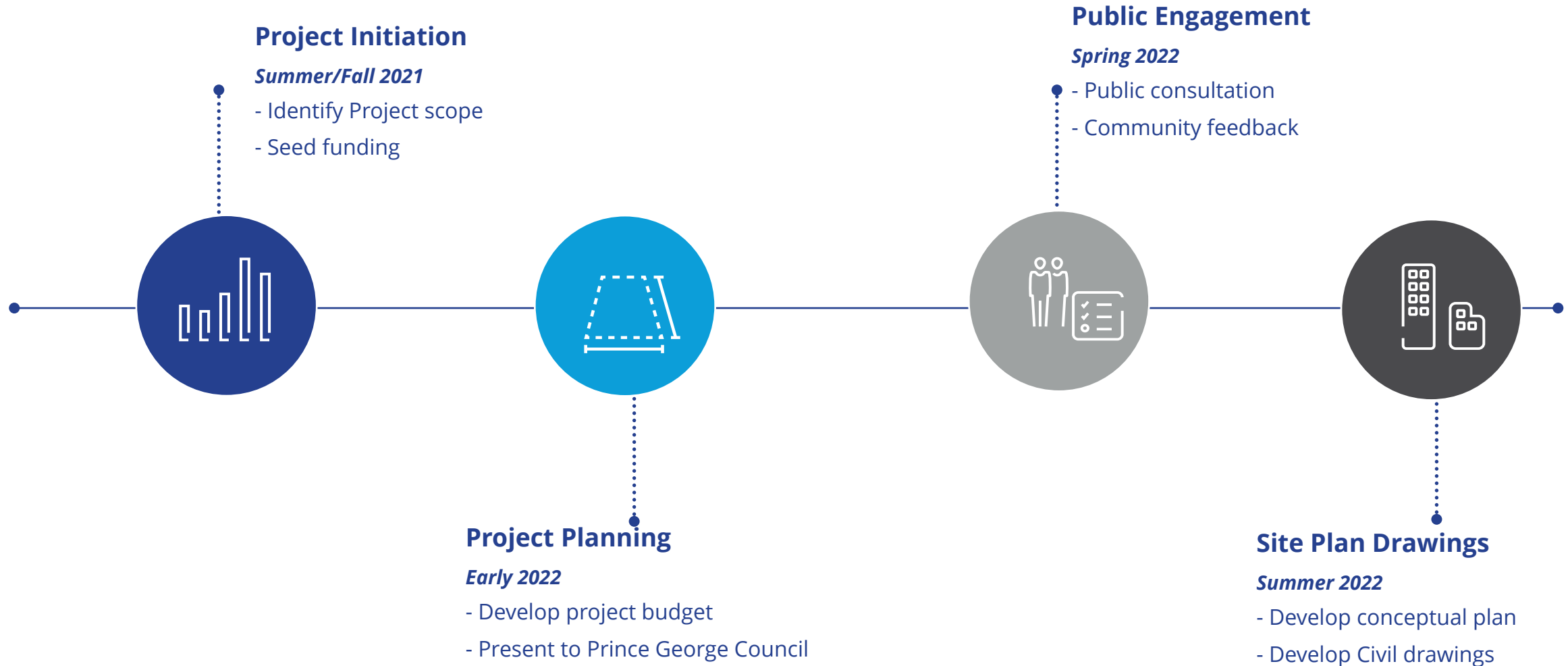

Budget/Estimates Pricing

| Description | Amount |
|--------------------------------|------------------|
| Design / Consulting | 250,000 |
| Spray park | 300,000 |
| Junior adventure park | 135,000 |
| Teen adventure park with tower | 235,000 |
| Senior fitness stations | 75,000 |
| PumpTrack | 250,000 |
| All accessible playground | 1,100,000 |
| Contingency & Escalation | 500,000 |
| Total | 2,845,000 |
