CITY OF PRINCE GEORGE BYLAW NO. 9042, 2019

A Bylaw of the City of Prince George to amend certain text of the City of Prince George Zoning Bylaw No. 7850, 2007.

WHEREAS pursuant to the provisions of Section 479 of *the Local Government Act*, in relation to zoning, the Council of the City of Prince George is empowered to make regulations thereto;

AND WHEREAS "City of Prince George Zoning Bylaw No. 7850, 2007" has been adopted to make regulations thereto;

WHEREAS the Council of the City of Prince George has deemed it desirable to amend "City of Prince George Zoning Bylaw 7850, 2007" by adding "retail, general only in religious assembly" as a permitted use in the P2: Minor Institutional zone on the subject property;

- 2. That the Mayor and Corporate Officer are hereby empowered to do all things necessary to give effect to this Bylaw.
- 3. That this Bylaw may be cited for all purposes as the "City of Prince George Zoning Bylaw No. 7850, 2007, Amendment Bylaw No. 9042, 2019".
