PURPOSE:

This information report provides a summary of Building Permits and Development Permits issued for the months of August, September, and October 2022. This report also provides Council with a comparison of issued Building Permit(s) for the months of August, September, and October in the years 2020, 2021 and 2022. Please see attached Building Permit data for the months of August, September, and October for 2020, 2021 and 2022.

BUILDING PERMIT:

Significant Building Permit(s) issued in August, September and October 2022 (i.e. residential, commercial, industrial and institutional), and the estimated total construction value of each development are provided below. The construction values reflect the construction of the building/structure, and do not include the cost of any mechanical equipment.

Residential Development for the Month of August

- Six (6) new single-family dwellings (\$ 3,700,700);
- Eight (8) single family dwelling alterations: and
- Two (2) new mobile dwellings (\$ 338,656).

Commercial, Industrial and Institutional Development for the Month of August

- Six (6) commercial building alterations (\$713,270); and
- Five (5) new industrial buildings (\$6,500,000).

Residential Development for the Month of September

- Five (5) new multi-family dwellings (\$ 2,500,000);
- One (1) new duplex dwellings (\$ 914,080);
- Fifteen (15) new single-family dwellings (\$ 7,999,416); and
- Six (6) single-family dwelling alterations (\$ 348,374).

Commercial, Industrial and Institutional Development for the Month of September

• Two (2) new commercial buildings (\$205,000).

Residential Development for the Month of October

- One (1) new multi-family dwelling (\$ 17,349,578);
- Five (5) new single-family dwellings (\$ 3,600,348); and
- Nine (9) single-family dwelling alterations (\$ 915,115).

Commercial, Industrial and Institutional Development for the Month of October

- Two (2) new commercial buildings (\$5,425,001);
- Four (4) commercial alterations (467,365);
- Four (4) new industrial buildings (\$ 301,000); and
- One (1) institutional alteration (\$ 1,459,921).

DEVELOPMENT PERMIT:

The Department approved two (2) Development Permits for the month of August:

- DP100735 5684 5678 Leland Rd Construction of a Carriage House.
