I am a senior living in the Millar Addition area within two blocks of the proposed liquor store at 1933 Queensway Street. This neighbourhood already faces many challenges such as homelessness, pan-handling, littering of used drug paraphernalia, and high rates of B&E's to name a few. The addition of a liquor store, in my opinion, will only increase these behaviours in a negative way.

This neighbourhood has an abundance of seniors, families with young children and it should be a healthy, safe place to live and play. I personally do not feel safe walking my dog at night in this neighbourhood and this proposed establishment will only increase that in a negative way.

Unfortunately, sex trade workers are in abundance in this neighbourhood and their clientele are constantly circling the blocks in and around the proposed liquor store site, and I believe this behaviour would increase immensely in a negative way.

Do we need a liquor store here? The answer is NO! There are many available locations to purchase alcohol without it being in my back yard.
