The nature of my email today is to voice my opposition to rezoning the “Old Pizza Hut” property and building at 1933 Queensway Street to allow for a liquor store to operate in this building.

My objection is supported by the circumstances we in the Millar Addition face today. Increased crime and vagrancy to say the least over the past 3 years has escalated to a level where we are afraid in our homes.

We have enough problems now. There have been attacks on the elderly and anyone working in their yard or out for a walk are met with the threat of physical violence, emotional and verbal abuse from persons in the encampment, vagrant persons with criminal records and future intent to commit offences along with drug addicts. Gun shots and open burning at the encampment is dangerous to our quality of life. We do not sleep sound at night and fear the spread of fires may burn our homes.

We have as a neighbourhood been burdened enough. Judge Hinkson seems to think the RCMP records are hearsay. You are asking us for patience.

A liquor store will only encourage an increase in attracting undesirable activities. To allow this is not sensible and the negative impact would furthermore disrespect our neighbourhood.

My request is Prince George City Council reconsider rezoning the property at 1933 Queensway and not allow the operation of a liquor store. A liquor retail business would provide an avenue for escalating the many social issues desecrating our neighbourhood now. Please say no.
