

CITY OF PRINCE GEORGE
BYLAW NO. 9391, 2023

A Bylaw of the City of Prince George to amend certain text of “City of Prince George Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Bylaw No. 8689, 2015.”

WHEREAS pursuant to the *Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act*, RSBC 1996, c. 165, as amended, Section 77 requires that Council designate a person or group of persons as the “head” for the purposes of the Act. Section 66 of the Act authorizes the “head” to delegate to any person any duty, power or function of the head. Section 13 of the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Regulation sets out the maximum fees for services provided pursuant to the Act;

AND WHEREAS “City of Prince George Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Bylaw No. 8689, 2015” has been adopted to make regulations thereto;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the City of Prince George has deemed it desirable that certain text and definitions be amended, added, removed, and replaced to provide consistency and clarity to the interpretation of the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Bylaw;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Prince George, in open meeting assembled, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That “City of Prince George Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Bylaw No. 8689, 2015”, be amended as follows:
 - a. That the following definitions in section 1.2 be deleted in their entirety and replaced with the following:

““Coordinator” means the person or persons designated under section 2.2 of this Bylaw as the Information and Privacy Coordinator; and

“Head” means the person designated under section 2.1 of this Bylaw as the Head in accordance with the Act.”
 - b. that Section 2.1 be amended by deleting the words “General Manager of Administrative Services” and replacing them with “City Manager”;
 - c. that Section 2.2 be deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

“2.2 The Manager of Legislative Services (Corporate Officer) and the Supervisor of Information and Privacy, be each designated a Coordinator of the City for the purposes of the Act.”
2. That the Mayor and Corporate Officer are hereby empowered to do all things necessary to give effect to this Bylaw.
3. That this Bylaw may be cited for all purposes as the “City of Prince George Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Bylaw No. 8689, 2015, Amendment Bylaw No. 9391, 2023.”
