They offer a wide scope of services, all aimed at supporting holistic wellness for their community members. All the programs are built on a strong cultural foundation, uniquely blended with leading evidence-based approaches.

Carrier Sekani Family Services is applying for funding opportunities to build on the Pillars of Hope and Strength project. This project involves the establishment of a series of commemorative signage and two artistic pillars that will be carved and installed at either end of Highway 16 in Prince George and Prince Rupert. These commemorative markers will help raise awareness of missing and murdered indigenous women and girls, honor the lives of those lost, and will provide an opportunity for family members and loved ones to continue their journey of healing. This grant will provide support for cultural infrastructure that they intend to use for the Pillar Project including the Pillars of Hope and Strength, billboards, rest stop kiosks, and more.
