
What is the Primary Reserve?

- The Primary Reserve is the part time component of the Canadian Armed Forces.
- The Primary Reserve is divided into three sub-components:
 - The Army Reserve
 - The Naval Reserve
 - The Air Reserve
- Reservists serve on a part time basis in their own community.



Who we are

- The RM RANG is a P Res Infantry Regiment within the 39 Canadian Brigade Group.
