
- → In 2022, capital initiatives completed or underway in 2022 include:

Looking Ahead: 2023 So Far

- → Strong recovery in passenger numbers has continued, with 96,778 passengers transiting YXS in Q1 and 101,835 in Q2 (up 44% from 2022).
- The expansion of our ARFF shelter has been completed to allow for the accommodation of a new fire truck.
- We signed the Prince George Airport Authority Lheidli T'enneh First Nation Collaboration Agreement in February.
- Flight availability has continued to increase, with additional capacity to Vancouver and Calgary on WestJet and Air Canada being announced for the summer.
