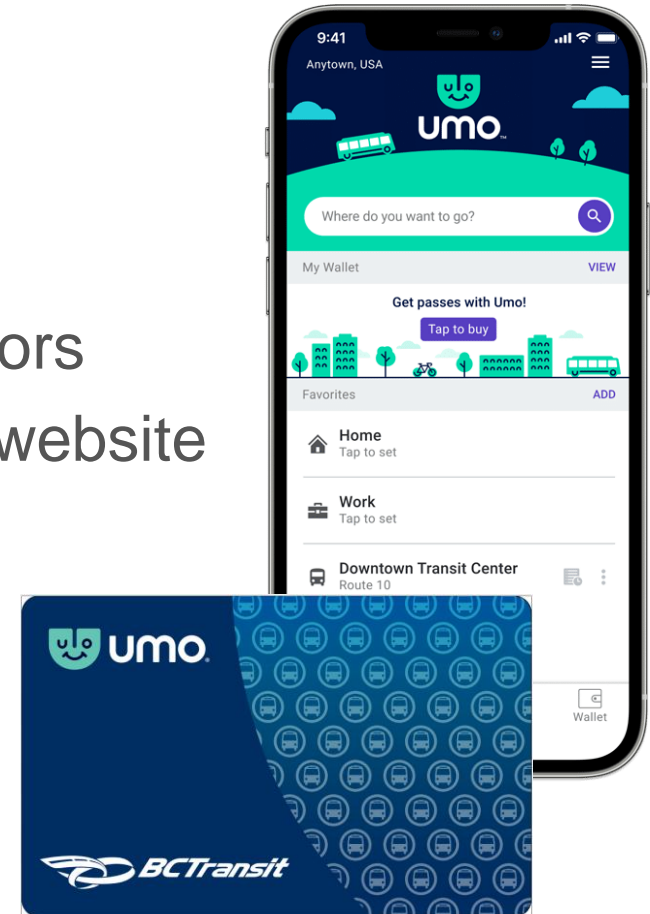
Umo Project

- Project Overview
 - Introduce new ways for riders to purchase and use their bus fares
 - Replace dated and costly technology
 - Emphasis on self-serve approach
 - Increase and improve data collected
- Project Outcomes
 - Make choosing transit more convenient to increase ridership
 - Cash remains as a payment option



Customer Experience

- Customer-Facing Components
 - Umo mobile app
 - Available through retail vendors
 - Managed through customer website
 - Reloadable card
 - Validator onboard all buses
 - Future acceptance of credit and debit tap payments
 - Dedicated customer call centre to support riders



Fare Policy Changes

- Three new universal policies being introduced to:
 - Maximize the customer benefits within the new system and create a consistent customer experience.
 - Align policies to the configuration capabilities of Umo.
- For information
 - Universal refund policy
 - Refunds available for unused fare products. Refunds not available for partially used or expired fare products. Refunds available on stored value amounts of greater than \$10.00.

Fare Policy Changes

- For information
 - Universal expiration policy
 - Pre-purchased packs of 10 rides (previously tickets), or portions thereof, and DayPASS fare products will expire after 365 days from the date of purchase.

Fare Policy Changes

- For information
 - Cash Balance
 - A Cash Balance is a sum of money loaded to a rider's Umo account that gets deducted from as additional trips are taken.
 - Umo will cap the Cash Balance payment method after the second trip of the day, meaning that customers never pay more than the value of a DayPASS when using a Umo payment method.

Fare Policy Changes

- For approval
 - 30-Day Pass
 - Change from current date-bound monthly pass
 - I.e., March 1 to March 31
 - Customer benefits of 30-Day Pass
 - Can be purchased at any point in the month and used right away
 - Can also be set up to be automatically repurchased
