### City Service Delivery Model

City grants play a vital role in providing various programs and services related to arts and culture, social health, well-being, recreation, and events through its third-party service delivery model.

An average of 70 to 100 not-for-profit groups receives direct funding support from the City of Prince George annually.



### 2023 Grants Review


The grants review included engaging with not-for-profit organizations to better understand how City grants can be improved to meet their evolving needs.

### Other not-for-profit supports from the City

- Property tax exemptions
- Low cost leased civic assets
- Discounted rate for scheduling and renting facilities
- Service agreements
- In kind support for activities such as application support, events, and promotion







## TRANSITION OUT OF CURRENT MULTIYEAR FUNDING AGREEMENTS

TRANSITION OVER 4 YEARS, THE MULTIYEAR FUNDING AGREEMENTS RESULTING IN A CORRESPONDING \$263,152 INCREASE TO THE MYPG GRANT BUDGET



\$263,152

Transition of agreements

- Year 1= 100% of payment
- Year 2= 75% of payment
- Year 3= 50% of payment
- Year 4= 0% of payment

Once the transition period for Year 4 concludes, multi-year funding agreements are eligible for the new Operating Grant


