The Importance of Early Detection and Prevention

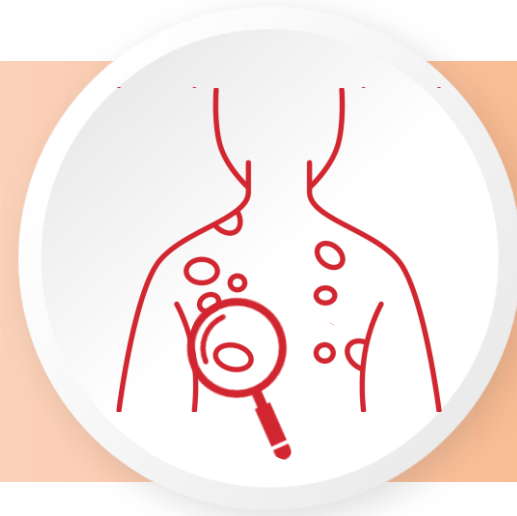
- Your skin is the largest organ of your body and the only organ visible to both yourself and your loved ones.

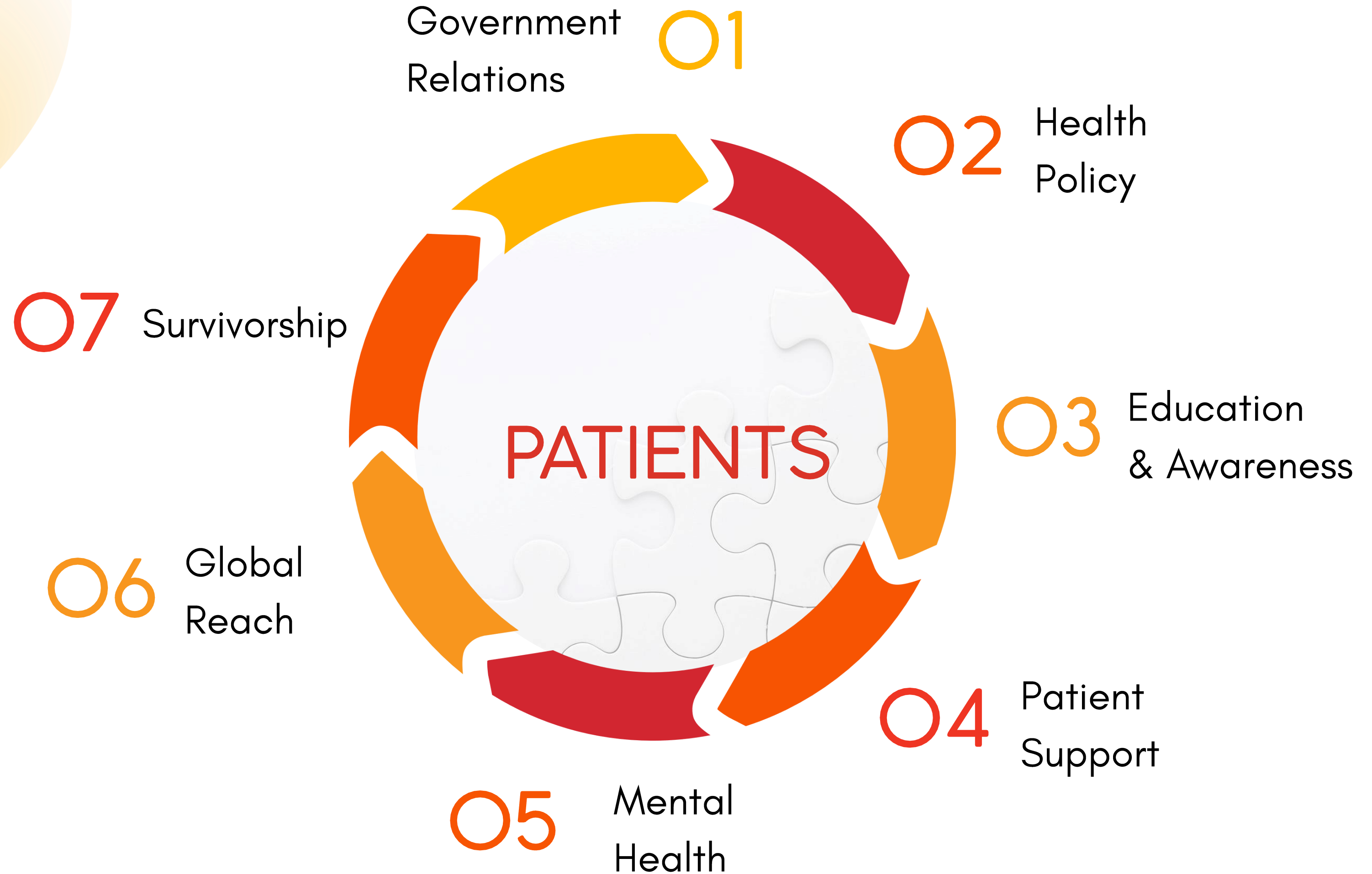
