

Prince George Heritage Commission Creative Spirit Award

The mission of the Prince George Heritage Commission is to protect, conserve and interpret heritage resources within the City of Prince George by supporting, encouraging and facilitating the conservation, maintenance and restoration of these resources.

The **Prince George Heritage Commission Creative Spirit Award** recognizes student initiative in interpreting and sharing heritage concepts in fresh and exciting ways.

The award is presented to a single project at the Prince George Regional Heritage Fair that meets the following two criteria:

- 1. The project has as its theme any place, person, object, organization or industry that has historical significance or heritage value for the population of North-Central British Columbia.
- 2. The project exhibits notable creativity, originality or uniqueness in its approach to documenting, interpreting and/or presenting information.

If no projects meet both criteria, the award may, at the Heritage Commission's discretion, be presented to a project that meets only the second criterion.

The award consists of a medal of recognition and a gift package from the Prince George Heritage Commission. When possible, the award shall be presented by a member of the Heritage Commission.
