

TO INCREASE THE MYPG BUDGET

THE FUNDS WILL BE USED FOR:

NEW GRANT STREAMS(TBD):

- 1.myPG Grant (<\$10,000)- EXISTING
- 2. Quick Response Grant (<\$2,500)
- 3. Operating Grant (% of overall operating expense up to a max of X\$)
- **4. Community Project Pooled Funder Grant**
- 5. Capacity Building, Training and Support

NEXT STEPS:

- Consultation with multiyear funding agreements and other NFPs
- Introduce Council's role to provide oversight and direction
- Ensure commitment to equity and accessibility
- Introduce Foundant (GLM Tool)
- Minor criteria adjustments to myPG grant criteria including minimal capital

DEFINITIONS MULTIYEAR FUNDING GRANTS:

MULTIYEAR FUNDING GRANTS

Multiyear funding is a recurring grant providing ongoing financial support to not-for-profits. The City uses multiyear funding agreements to enhance municipal services and quality-of-life programs, providing stability for long-term projects, operational costs, and regular services. These grants align with Council priorities and have delivered lasting value to residents.

STANDING GRANT/EXISTING AGREEMENTS

A standing grant for an existing multiyear funding agreement provides ongoing financial support for up to 4 years to a not-for-profit organization that has demonstrated sustainable and diverse financial resources and has established a successful long-term service to the community. It covers operational costs or regular programs, offering stable and consistent funding compared to one-time grants.

LIMITED DURATION OPERATING GRANT

A limited duration operating grant provides ongoing financial support for up to 2 years to a not-for-profit organization that has not received multiyear funding and is a NEW request. They must demonstrate sustainable and diverse financial resources and a successful longterm service to the community. It covers operational costs or regular programs, offering stable and consistent funding compared to one-time grants.

PROPOSED COUNCIL POLICY STREAM A STANDING GRANTS (EXISTING AGREEMENTS)

Objective: to provide financial support to registered not-for profits that have an existing agreement. Dependent on completion of annual reporting, allocations are approved by council and accounted for in the annual operating budget cycle.

REPORTING

- Administration will ensure reporting outlined in the funding agreement is received via either:
 - Annual Report
 - Annual presentation to council
- Includes option to request additional funding

COMITTEE REVIEW

- Reports &/OR presentations will be reviewed through either proposed COTW or F&A
- Recommendations for funding considered through a review process

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FOLLOW UP

Administration will complete

- Funding Agreement for term
- Payment for term on an annual basis



APPROVAL

 Council will receive information on reports Council will make final decision on funding

PROPOSED COUNCIL POLICY STREAM B LIMITED DURATION 2 YEAR OPERATING GRANT (NEW GRANT STREAM)

Objective: to provide support to registered not-for profits overall operating costs and are not designated for any specific project or activity. Applications are accepted once per year with an intake deadline of January (proposed). Allocations are a certain percentage of the organizations overall operating budget up to max of certain amount.

APPLY

- Apply through City website
- Managed through Foundant

PRELIMINARY SCREENING

Administration to review applications for completeness and provide a summary of proposed recommendations for adjudication to the committee

COMMITTEE REVIEW

 Applications will be adjudicated through either proposed COTW or F&A

APPROVAL

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Council will grant final approval for applications



FOLLOW UP

Administration will complete with successful applicants


- Agreement form for term
- Complete payment for term (on an annual basis)

REPORTING

Administration will ensure reporting is received via either;

- Annual Report
- Annual presentation to council

PROPOSED COUNCIL POLICY GOVERNANCE STRUCTURE



- Reviewing and evaluating multiyear funding reporting (standing grants) and applications (limited duration operating grants) will necessitate a significant time investment.
- Either Committee option enables meetings to be scheduled outside the regular Council schedule, allowing for flexible and informal discussions, including presentations from applicants.
- Either committee option supports the review process and effectively facilitate Council's involvement.

NOTE: Council retains the authority to grant final approval for all multiyear funding agreements & amounts



PROPOSED COUNCIL POLICY IMPLEMENTATION TIMELINE & NEXT STEPS

TIMELINE

Initiate Process: January 2025

Example-launch Limited Duration 2 year **Operating Grant**

Review Period: April & May

The review period for both grant streams - April & May each year and will be done by governance option selected by Council

Council Approval: June

Funding recommendations approved by Council in May/June to align with the city's annual operating budget process deadlines





NEXT STEPS

Administration will:

- Further refine grant criteria, and eligibility, guidelines and reporting information
- Create forms (e.g. application and reporting templates etc.)
- Set up process in Foundant
- Create grants webpage content
- Promote Limited Duration 2 year **Operating Grant**
- Provide transition support to existing agreements (Standing Grants)
- Assist new applicants with the application process (Limited Duration 2 year Operating Grant)
