The Little Prince train had been operated by the Fort George Railway Society from 1970 – 2006. The society struggled

with volunteers and resources and the train required major mechanical repairs resulting in the train sitting idle from 2006 – 2010. The City negotiated a 5 year agreement in 2011 with the Fraser Fort George Museum Society (FFGMS) to operate the heritage steam train and assets in Lheidli T'enneh Memorial Park which has been renewed annually since 2016.
