EMCR looks forward to continuing to work with you and your team regarding improvements to the current summer rental Reception Centre model. EMCR will follow up with Lheidli T'enneh regarding discussions on the bridge to connect the Shelley Reserves and it's consideration as a secondary emergency egress route.

More information will be coming out about this work after the election interregnum. EMCR Senior Regional Manager, Tony Fiala, will be in contact with City of Prince George staff to discuss host community funding support options for 2025.
