Purpose:

The purpose of this report is to update Council on the activities and achievements of the Advisory Committee on Accessibility and Inclusion and to provide the Committee's proposed 2025 work plan for Council's consideration.

Background:

The Advisory Committee on Accessibility and Inclusion is a Council Committee guided by its Council-approved Terms of Reference mandate to advise Mayor and Council and City Staff on the identification, removal, and prevention of physical, social, and attitudinal barriers to individuals in or interacting with the City of Prince George as an organization or which impedes the full participation of all citizens in every aspect of community life.

Work of the Committee 2024:

In 2024, the committee held four meetings to address items included within its 2024 work plan. The committee reviewed and advised on the following:

- 67 service requests related to barriers on accessibility
- Prioritizing potential project concepts for preparing a SPARC BC accessibility grant application
- 21 action items update contained in the City's 2023-2026 Work Plan

Overview of 2025 Work Plan

Attached to this report is the proposed 2025 work plan, which reflects the committee's focus on reviewing feedback regarding accessibility barriers within the City of Prince George and feedback on the City's Accessibility Work Plan. The committee is expected to review service requests, identify key issues, and advise on future actions to be incorporated into the updated plan.

Summary and conclusion:

The Advisory Committee on Accessibility and Inclusion respectfully requests Council's approval of its 2025 work plan and looks forward to continuing its efforts to identify, prevent, and remove barriers that impede the full participation of individuals in or interacting with the City of Prince George.
