The Lheidli T'enneh Nation is pleased to offer our formal endorsement and approval in support of the proposed New Playground at Lheidli T'enneh Memorial Park.

As you are aware, we are deeply familiar with the historical significance of the site. We have carefully reviewed the results of the archaeological investigations, including ground-penetrating radar scans, which were shared with us. Additionally, we held a meeting with the archaeologist involved in the project. Based on this review, we can confirm that no significant evidence of burials was found at any of the sites (PG1, PG2, or PG3).

We do not foresee any concerns arising from the development of this project. We understand that the construction of the New Playground will involve minimal disturbance or excavation of the site, which is reassuring given the cultural importance of the location. We are pleased that the proposed playground will cause limited impact on this area of historical significance.

The Lheidli T'enneh Nation fully supports this project for the benefit of our community.
