RECOMMENDATION(S):

That Council RECEIVES FOR INFORMATION the report dated January 10, 2020 from the City Manager, titled "Engineering Services Year 2020 Budget Increase".

PURPOSE:

The purpose of this report is to provide Council with information, related to questions that arose during the January 6th budget meeting, concerning the \$579,000 increase of the 2020 Engineering Services Service Category budget over the 2019 budget.

STRATEGIC PRIORITIES:

The Engineering Services Year 2020 budget relates to the myPG Goals of: Sustainable Infrastructure, Sustainable Fiscal Management, and Organizational Excellence.

FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS:

Below please find a table that outlines the staff transitions and related funding impacts of the Engineering Services Year 2020 budget. As indicated on page 93 of the budget book, the total cost of the Service Category increased by approximately \$579,000 in 2020 over 2019. Transfers from other service categories funded \$417,000 (rounded) of the increased costs. \$162,000 (rounded) is the net service category cost increase. That increase includes the addition of one new FTE, a Municipal Engineer. In 2021, the additional FTE and costs associated with it will be offset by the elimination of a position due to a retirement in the department.
