Purpose:

The purpose of this report is to provide Council with a summary of Building Permits and Development Permits issued in May 2025, as well as a comparison of Building Permits issued for the month of May in the years 2023 and 2024.

Building Permits:

Please see the summary below of Building Permits issued in May of 2025 (i.e., residential, commercial, industrial, and institutional), and the estimated total construction value of development. The construction values reflect the construction of the building or structure and do not include the cost of any mechanical equipment.

Commercial, Industrial and Institutional Development

• Two (2) commercial building alterations (\$1,125,000).

Residential Development

- Two (2) new two-unit (duplex) permits issued facilitating 4 new dwelling units (\$2,222,456);
- Two (2) new single-family dwelling permits (\$1,026,496);
- Five (5) new secondary suites constructed in various housing forms (\$117,705); and
- One (1) new multi-family permit issued facilitating 43 units (\$15,400,000).

Development Permits:

In May 2025, the Department approved the following Development Permits:

- DP100911 1177 Foothills Boulevard Minor amendment to a Multiple Residential Form and Character Development Permit to facilitate the development of a 91-dwelling unit, apartment
- DP100912 1681 10th Avenue Intensive Residential Development Permit to facilitate the development of a single-detached house on an infill lot.
- DP100913 1689 10th Avenue Intensive Residential Development Permit to facilitate the development of a single-detached house on an infill lot.
