- 2. Review options for identifying a leader of the Program. After a review of past and current duties similar to this program, it has been determined that the scope of the program will determine the best fit.

The Communications Division would create a section on the City website on the Awards and Recognition page https://www.princegeorge.ca/community-culture/awards-recognition. It was suggested to include a short biography along with a photo of each recipient.
- 4. Create an overview of the Program Framework. Administration has attached a draft document for further direction from the Committee.
