Thank you Your Worship for receiving my submission this evening. I recently became a home owner in the Alpine Village complex off of Upland Street between 20th Avenue and Strathcona.

As you may or may not know, there are over 200 single-family housing units off this street. After the snow events of the week of February 3rd, 2020, the road was not plowed or sanded for several days, causing many people to get stuck in the street, and making access to Alpine Village treacherous.

I would like to request that this road be re-classified to a Priority 2 road instead of a residential street in the snow clearing plan. **Due to the population density**, the traffic either quickly turns the road into a sheet of ice, or a gauntlet of stuck cars. Also due to the socio-economic status of the area, many people living on Upland Street do not have four wheel drive, including myself. They may or may not also have access to funds to tow their cars out of the street.

I would also like to request that one side of the road becomes a seasonal no-parking side.
