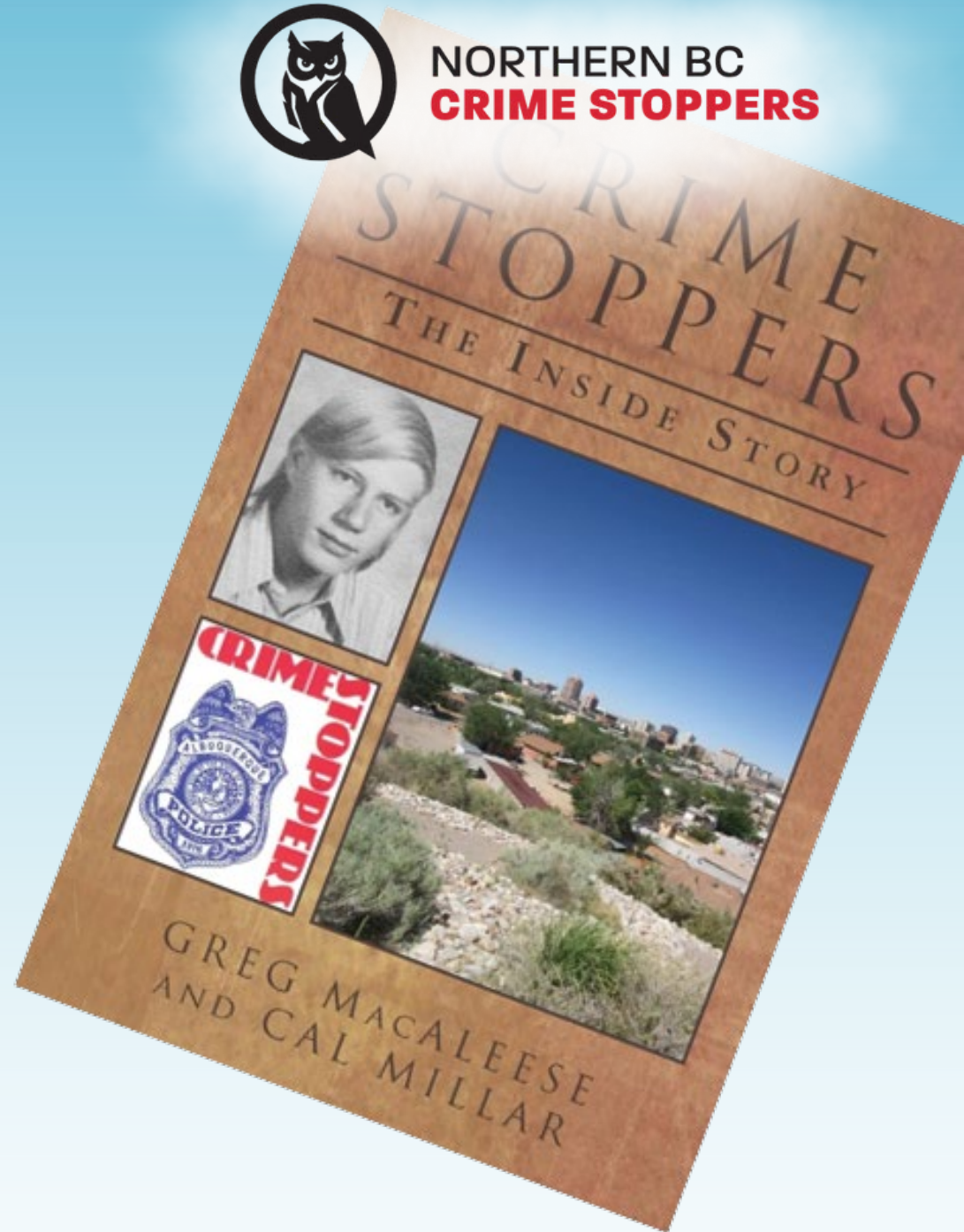

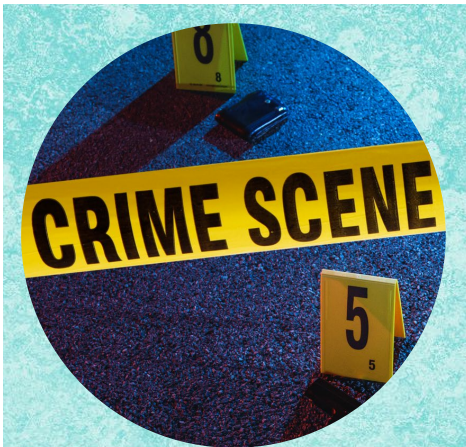

## Local Program Support

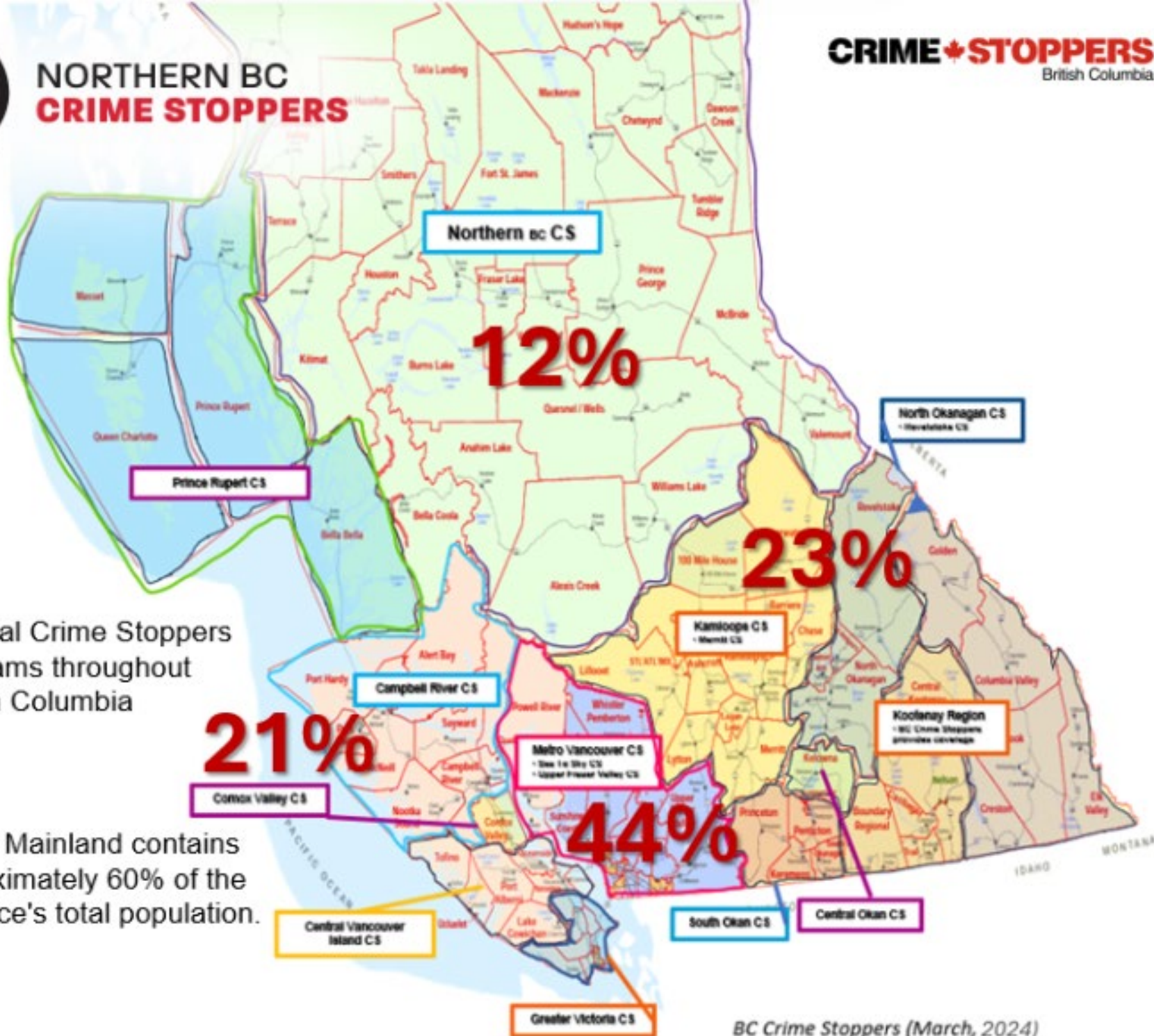
BC Crime Stoppers provides direction, guidance, and assistance to Crime Stoppers programs throughout British Columbia.

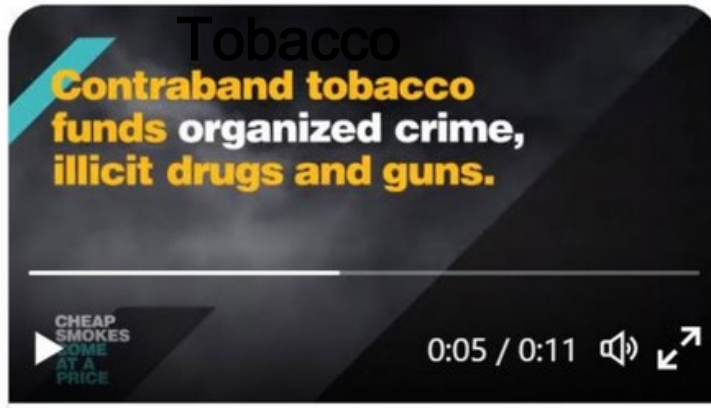

# 2024 IMPACT REPORT

Crime Stoppers is a not-for-profit organization that works with law enforcement to help solve crimes and improve public safety.

**How it works:**

- People can provide tips anonymously.
- Calls never recorded or traced - we don't want your name.
- Information is shared with the police.
- If the information solves the case or leads to an arrest, the caller may be eligible for a cash reward.

As of May 2023, the Combined Forces Special Enforcement Unit (CFSEU) estimates that approximately 188 gangs operate within British Columbia.

- arms trafficking
- violent crimes
- money laundering

- extortion
- contraband (tobacco & cannabis)

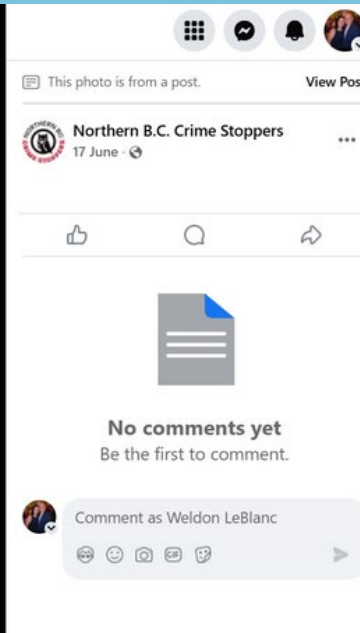

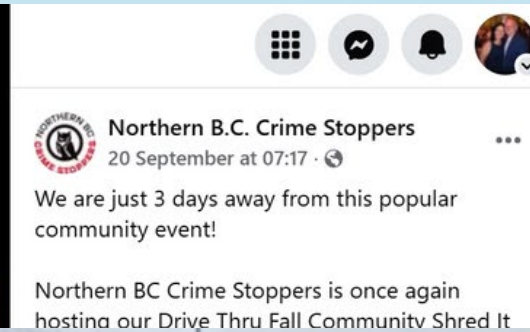
