I am writing to formally express my strong opposition to the proposed apartment building behind my 0.86-acre lot on Greenwood Street. I have lived here for nearly 10 years, drawn by the quiet neighborhood and spacious yard. I am concerned that Greenwood, Chief Lake Road, and Sparwood cannot safely handle the increased traffic this development would bring, especially given the lack of sidewalks, street lighting, and bus stops. Our neighborhood consists of single-family homes, and I believe it should remain that way. This project would likely decrease my property value and make it more difficult to sell. Residents choose this area for its current character, not for high-density development. My husband and I are firmly opposed to this proposal and urge you to reconsider.
