

CITY OF PRINCE GEORGE
BYLAW NO. 9529, 2025

A Bylaw of the City of Prince George to amend “City of Prince George Tree Protection Bylaw No. 6343, 1995”.

WHEREAS Council has adopted “City of Prince George Tree Protection Bylaw No. 6343, 1995” to prohibit and/or regulate the cutting of trees within the municipality’

AND WHEREAS the Council of the City of Prince George has deemed it desirable that certain text and definitions be added, removed and replaced to provide consistency and clarity to the interpretation of the Tree Protection Bylaw;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the City of Prince George, in open meeting assembled, **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. That “City of Prince George Tree Protection Bylaw No. 6343, 1995”, be amended as follows:
 - a. that Section 3 – “Definitions” be amended by:
 - i. deleting the words “City of Prince George Official Community Plan Bylaw No. 8383, 2011” and replacing with the words “the City of Prince George Official Community Plan” in the definition of “Official Community Plan”; and
 - ii. deleting the words “City of Prince George Zoning Bylaw No. 7850, 2007” and replacing with the words “the City of Prince George Zoning Bylaw” in the definition of “Zoning Bylaw”.
2. That the Mayor and Corporate Officer are hereby empowered to do all things necessary to give effect to this Bylaw.
3. That this Bylaw may be cited for all purposes as the "City of Prince George Tree Protection Bylaw No. 6343, 1995, Amendment Bylaw No. 9529, 2025".
