## BACKGROUND:

The North Central Local Government Association (NCLGA) is one of the five area Associations within the Union of British Columbia Municipalities (UBCM). Established in 1955, the NCLGA is a non-profit, non-partisan association comprised of all elected officials in Northern British Columbia.

Representation on the Board of Directors assists the City to have direct involvement in connecting communities, identifying common challenges and facilitating positive change in the region through NCLGA's advocacy work.

## SUMMARY AND CONCLUSION:

At last year's annual general meeting and convention, Councillor Cori Ramsay was elected Second Vice-President. Councillor Ramsay is seeking to stand for election to First Vice-President at this year's NCLGA AGM and Convention on May 13-15, 2020 in Prince George. If elected, NCLGA will assume all costs of Councillor Ramsay to attend Board of Directors meetings.

Councillor Ramsay's governance experience includes chairing the Two Rivers Gallery Board, and sitting on the Finance and Audit Committee, the Advisory Committee on Accessibility, and the Select Committee on Poverty Reduction.
