RE: Request for Mayoral Proclamation – Human Trafficking Prevention Day

Dear Mayor Yu,

On behalf of the Standing Committee on Intergovernmental Affairs, I am writing to respectfully request a mayoral proclamation declaring **Human Trafficking Prevention Day** on **February 19, 2026**, in the City of Prince George.

Human Trafficking Prevention Day recognizes that human trafficking is present in our community and that the City of Prince George in collaboration with local organizations is committed to protecting vulnerable people and supporting survivors.

Declaring this day would help raise further awareness about the severity of human trafficking in communities in the hopes of strengthening prevention.

The City of Prince George is the first municipality in British Columbia to sign the Statement of Support for the Human Trafficking Prevention Network and in fact aligned that signing during Victims and Survivors of Crime Week.

Proclaiming February 19, 2026, as Human Trafficking Prevention Day would continue to strengthen our message.
