Purpose:

This report supports the addition of three updates to the previously approved 2026 Standing Committee on Intergovernmental Affairs Work Plan.

Background:

The Standing Committee on Intergovernmental Affairs reviewed and approved a 2026 Committee Work Plan at the meeting held on November 4, 2025. During a review of resolutions previously passed by Council and the Committee, staff have updates to the work plan as attached.

The three added resolutions include:

That Council REFERS unfunded capital project #1192 – Hart Connector Trail New to the Standing Committee on Intergovernmental Affairs to explore advocacy opportunities.

That Council REFERS the matter of emergency services to the Standing Committee on Intergovernmental Affairs to consider advocacy opportunities regarding the funding of emergency programs and services in and around Prince George.

That Council REFERS the matter of the hospital parkade to the Standing Committee on Intergovernmental Affairs to explore advocacy opportunities regarding a grant-in-lieu of property tax payment from the Province for the hospital parkade property.
