## Recommendation(s):

## Purpose:

This report provides updates for “in progress” or “recurring” Council and Committee resolutions directing the work of the Standing Committee on Intergovernmental Affairs.

## Background:

At the October 1, 2024, meeting of the Standing Committee on Intergovernmental Affairs, the Committee passed a resolution directing administration to maintain a database that includes action oriented resolutions made at a committee meeting, tracks the progress of such resolutions including their priority, and that a list of the resolutions including status be included on a committee meeting agenda on an intermittent basis.

A copy of the resolution tracker is attached with notes on the status of “in progress” and “recurring” items, including reasons for closing certain items. Further information regarding certain items is detailed below where the item is now believed to be complete.

## Resolutions of the Standing Committee on Intergovernmental Affairs

IA2025-003 / BC Ambulance Service: This item is marked as complete. A resolution was submitted to UBCM and endorsed by membership. Advocacy to the Province continues on other aspects of the resolution.

IA2026-006 / NCLGA Resolutions: This item is marked for completion.

IA2025-012 / Economic Issues: This item is marked for completion, as a letter from the Chair has been sent to Honorable Ravi Kahlon, Minister of Jobs, Economic Development and

Innovation regarding the decision to withdraw funding for technology entrepreneurship in Northern BC.

IA2025-019 / Obstetrical Care at UHNBC: This item is marked for completion. A presentation on recruitment from Northern Health was delivered at the March 3, 2026, Standing Committee on Intergovernmental Affairs.

IA2025-021 / 2025-507 Aboriginal Housing Management Association: This item is marked for completion. A resolution titled "Creating an Indigenous-led, Cross Sector Housing Alliance" was supported by Council and has been submitted to NCLGA and UBCM.

IA2026-013 / 2026-150 Closure Allowance for Major Industrial and Electrical Properties: This item is marked for completion as a resolution submitted to NCLGA was supported by Council.
