

Masich Place Stadium COVID-19 Facility Safety Procedure for Visitors

Site Management

- Masich Place Stadium is under construction and visitors to the facility must take caution.
- All visitors are asked to park in the parking lot off of Massey Dr. The Griffiths parking lot will be barricaded with signage and remain closed to the public.
- The Massey Drive entrance gates will be locked open to allow access to track. Patrons will be required to follow directional signage throughout facility.
- Hand sanitizer stations will be positioned at the Massey Drive entrance to facility and at the portable toilets.
- Portable toilets are on site and will be cleaned and disinfected three times per week by the contractor. City staff will clean and disinfect touch points in portables hourly and will be documented on the Stadium check.
- Alternating lanes (1, 3, 5, and 7) will be open for public walking on the track to allow physical distancing.
- Water fountain remains closed and no other food and drink is allowed in facility except for water in non-breakable containers.



Booked Use

- Rental bookings may be taken for user groups who have an approved Return to Sport plans.
- Rental bookings and all participants are required to follow COVID facility guidelines.
- Field bookings will allow a total of 50 attendees per booking.
- Consecutive bookings will require a 30 min break in between to allow for cleaning and sanitization.
- Arrive no more than 15 min before booking start time and wait in vehicle until facility is cleared.
- Exit facility immediately upon completion of booking and no congregating in parking lot.
- Restrict/Limit Facility/Space to maintain physical distancing and proper cleaning protocols:
 - > Bleachers partial seating areas will be open to allow for social distancing.
 - Equipment storage staff only
 - > Locker Rooms, Water Fountain, Concession- closed
 - > Patrons are required to come to the stadium dressed in appropriate attire change rooms not provided.

Signage

- A sign will be displayed at the main entrance referencing COVID-19 precautions stay home if ill, maintain physical distance, sanitize hands before and after visit, etc.
- Signage will be posted directing patrons through facility to control traffic flow and control touch points.
- Signage will be posted by the portable washrooms and by hand sanitizer reminding the public to sanitize hands and to keep physical distance.
- Sandwich boards will be placed on track reminding the public of physical distancing.

Illness Protocol

- Do not enter facility if you feel ill or the following common COVID-19 symptoms: fever, chills, cough, shortness of breath, sore throat, runny nose, headache, fatigue, diarrhea, loss of appetite, nausea and vomiting, and muscle aches.
- Do not enter facility if you have been around someone who is ill, presents COVID-19 symptoms or is awaiting test results.
- Do not enter facility if you have been out of the country within the last 14 days.
- If you become ill while onsite, please report illness to Northern Health immediately by calling the Northern Health COVID-19 online clinic at 1.844.645.7811.

Personal Hygiene

- Avoid touching eyes, nose or mouth.
- Cover your mouth and nose with a tissue or into your elbow when coughing or sneezing.
- It is essential to use hand sanitizer when entering the facility and after visit.
- Do not share equipment unless it is disinfected before and after use.
- Always maintain a distance of two (2) meters from others.
- Be mindful of common surfaces and limit touch points.
- No spitting.

Sanitation

- General cleaning and disinfection of surfaces will occur daily.
- Additional cleaning and disinfection of all touchpoints (door handles, faucets, portable toilets, handrails, etc.) will occur hourly.
- Cleaning protocols will be posted at the stadium with material safety data sheets for cleaning/sanitizing products.
- Documentation of cleaning and disinfection will be recorded in the daily check list.
- City of Prince George designated cleaners will be cleaning and disinfecting Masich Place Stadium and staff will ensure cleaning and disinfection equipment and supplies are onsite and stocked regularly.
