Subject: City of Prince George resolution in support of the Northern Development Initiative Trust funding request (Prince George Golf and Curling Club – Recreation Infrastructure)

Dear Mayor and Council,

The Prince George Golf and Curling Club is formally requesting a resolution from Prince George City Council in support of our funding request to NDIT for up to \$50,000 (to be submitted in the near future).

The Prince George Golf and Curling Club (PGGCC) in conjunction with their lease tenants provides sporting opportunities for multiple user groups including Golf, Curling, Hockey, Climbing, Tennis, and Pickleball. The PGGCC is planning facility improvements to its existing Clubhouse which is used by all these groups. The work involves upgrading the current 35+ year old overhead lighting with modern LED fixtures. The project will improve the PGGCC's energy efficiency which would have positive environmental benefits and result in reduced long-term cost savings through reduced electricity bills. The brighter lighting will improve safety and ensure that the facility remains inviting for family-oriented activities for residents and visitors to Prince George.

The following is the resolution that we are asking City Council to approve:

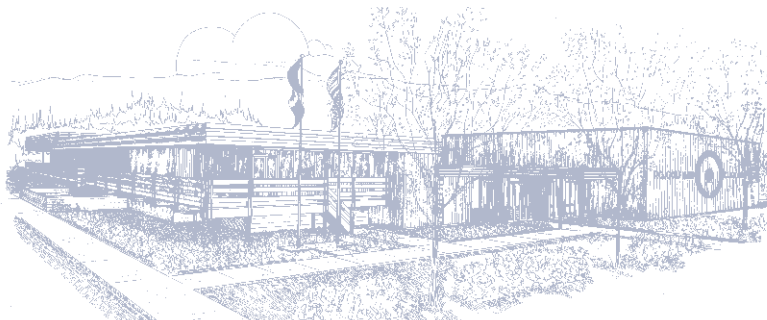
