The North Central Local Government Association (NCLGA) is one of the five area Associations within the Union of British Columbia Municipalities (UBCM). Established in 1955, the NCLGA is a non-profit, non-partisan association comprised of all elected officials in Northern British Columbia.

Representation on the Board of Directors assists the City to have direct involvement in connecting communities, identifying common challenges and facilitating positive change in the region through NCLGA's advocacy work

SUMMARY AND CONCLUSION:

At the 2020 annual general meeting and convention, Councillor Cori Ramsay was elected First Vice-President. Councillor Ramsay is now seeking to stand for election for the position of President at the 2021 virtual NCLGA AGM and Convention scheduled for May 5-6.
