Prince George City Council:

The intent of this letter is to provide written confirmation of the amendment of temporary use permit TU000067 - 681 Ongman Road as well as address some concerns in regards to the operations of my business.

Due to the fact that administration is not able to support the proposed "animal breeding and boarding" I have decided to remove boarding from my intended uses and continue with my application for the sole purposes of dog daycare, training and in the future potentially grooming.

In regards to the noise level reduction in order to reduce impacts of adjacent neighbors we are planning to install appropriate sound barriers inside the facility. We would also like to confirm that the dogs are not kenneled but play in a group setting. This in itself reduces noise as the dogs will be contently playing amongst themselves versus potentially distressed, locked in a kennel.

Our daycare is an indoor facility but we will be implementing outdoor hikes into our everyday schedule. We currently have a dog transportation bus that we will use to transport our client dogs to remote locations suitable for on or off leash dog walking. This in turn will also reduce the noise level - as the dogs will likely be very tired upon returning back to the daycare.

Due to the fact our daycare is indoors, there will be messes. We would like to address that we are taking all precautions to handle these messes safely and appropriately. All liquid waste will be soaked using an enzymatic cleaner suitable for pet urine and flushed down the drain using plenty of water. There will be no solids introduced into the ground drain. All solid matter will be properly composted.
