


Transit Future Action Plan

- Transit Service improvements over the next 5 years
- Infrastructure improvements in the short to medium term
- Supports Transit Mode share target of 4% by 2038
- Improve travel time
- Better connects growing neighbourhoods
- Proposed changes informed by Public Engagement

Impact of COVID-19


- Began shortly after the public engagement for the plan had been completed
- Affected ridership and travel patterns
- The timelines within the plan are flexible and depend on return of key markets, such as post-secondary students



Short-term Priorities


105 Pine Centre Express/Downtown Express

- New express service connecting Downtown, Spruceland Exchange, and Pine Centre Exchange
- 2,500 annual service hours
- 2 additional buses



Short-term Priorities

- 15 UNBC/Downtown & 115 UNBC Express/Downtown Express
- New express service along 15th Avenue and additional trips on the 15 UNBC/Downtown
- 1,500 annual service hours
- 1 additional bus



Short-term Priorities

Improved Weekday Evening Service

- 88 Westgate/89 Hart, 55 Victoria, 15 UNBC/Downtown, 10 Spruceland Downtown
- 4,200 annual service hours
- 1 additional bus


Improved Weekend Service

- 88 Westgate/89 Hart, 5/55 Victoria, 15 UNBC/Downtown, 10 Spruceland Downtown
- 4,850 annual service hours
- 2 additional buses

Medium-term Priorities

Redesign of 88 Westgate/89 Hart


- Breaking up the routes into three sections
- Improving service to match service standards
- 11,600 annual service hours and 6 additional buses in ultimate design
- Can be phased over several years



Long-term Priorities

Introduce Service to Airport


- New service to airport/industrial areas
- 4 trips/day
- 850 annual service hours
- 1 additional bus



Long-term Priorities

Improving Route Directness

- Breaking up long loop routes into shorter, linear routes
- 1 Heritage, 5/55 Victoria, and 46/47 Queensway
- Additional service hours and vehicles to be determined



Infrastructure Proposals

- Continued bus stop improvements
- Transit Exchanges
 - Downtown Exchange
 - Pine Centre Exchange
 - Spruceland Exchange
 - UNBC, Hart, & Westgate Exchanges
- New Operations & Maintenance Facility



New & Emerging Technologies

- Smartbus
 - Automatic Passenger
 Counters (APC)
 - CCTV
 - Automatic vehicle locator (AVL)
- BC Transit's Low Carbon Fleet Program
- Mobility as a Service (MaaS)
- Digital on Demand
- Autonomous Vehicles



Summary

- In totality the plan includes:
 - An additional 25,500 annual service hours
 - An additional 13 buses added to the transit fleet
 - Upgrades to existing transit exchanges
 - Improvements to customer amenities at transit stops
 - A new operations and maintenance facility to accommodate increased vehicle capacity and be adaptable to the requirements of BC Transit's Low Carbon Fleet Program

Recommendation

That Council endorses the Prince George Transit Future Action Plan.
