## Subject: BC Hydro and Power Authority 2020 Street Lighting Rate Application

At their April 12 meeting, City of Campbell River Council received copies of correspondence from the Cities of Vernon and Prince George, which they sent to UBCM and the BC Utilities Commission respectively, outlining their concerns about BC Hydro's proposed surcharge, to recover costs incurred through switching from high pressure sodium to LED light fixtures.
