SUBJECT: Endorsement of Councillor Frizzell as the Past President on the Federation of Canadian Municipalities (FCM) Board of Directors

RECOMMENDATION:

That Council APPROVES the proposed resolution attached to the report dated May 4, 2021, from Mayor Lyn Hall, titled "Endorsement of Councillor Frizzell as the past president on the Federation of Canadian Municipalities (FCM) Board of Directors."

DISCUSSION:

The Federation of Canadian Municipalities (FCM) is an extremely effective policy advocacy organization, which brings local government perspectives to federal issues that impact municipalities.

Representation on FCM's National Board of Directors facilitates the City having a direct voice in the development of FCM policy. This work is very valuable to Prince George.

As noted in the attached motion, Council endorses Councillor Frizzell's succession from president to past president on the FCM's National Board of Directors and agrees to assume all costs of the member attending Board of Directors meetings.

As the outgoing president of the FCM Board of Directors, Councillor Frizzell will proceed through automatic succession and become the past president of the FCM Board of Directors for the period starting in June 2021 and ending October 2022. Councillor Frizzell has been elected as a member of the FCM National Board of Directors for 12 consecutive years and will be entering his 13th year in June 2021. His past roles included chairing the Governance Working Group, chairing Municipal Finance and Intergovernmental Arrangements, Chair of Conference Planning, and Governance Representative for two international programs related to economic development and resource communities.
