BACKGROUND:

Significant Building Permit(s) issued in May 2021 (i.e. residential, commercial, industrial and institutional), and the estimated total construction value of each development are provided below. The construction values reflect the construction of the building/structure, and do not include the cost of any mechanical equipment.

Residential Development

- Ten (10) new single family dwellings (\$4,374,386.00);
- Four (4) new multi-family apartments/townhouses (\$45,524,792.00); and
- One (1) new triplex (\$627,000.00).

Commercial, Industrial and Institutional Development

- Six (6) commercial building alterations (\$849,743.00); and
- Two (2) new industrial building (\$3,095,000.00);

The Department has approved the following Development Permit(s) for the month of May:

- DP100663 110 PG Pulpmill Rd. Riparian Protection DP to facilitate the construction of a vegetated berm
